Focus: Understanding light and shadow, realistic texture, pencil grip and control.

Unit 3: Color Theory and Application

Topic: Imaginative Landscape with Watercolor (40 Marks)

Skills Covered: Composition layout, color blending, perspective drawing, creative thinking.

- Components:

 - • Hills, trees, rivers

Focus: Use of watercolors, layering, highlighting, and natural blending.
