The 100% pass rate in the board exams, the growing confidence of our students, and the compassion shown through dignified last rites for the abandoned are milestones that reaffirm our mission.

Founded with a vision to provide quality education to those in need, we have since expanded our efforts to encompass a wide range of programs. Our initiatives now include skill development programs aimed at enhancing employability, livelihood and entrepreneurship programs to promote self-reliance, health and nutrition services to ensure overall well-being, and karmic initiatives to encourage community engagement and giving back.



The ultimate goal of Utsav Foundation extends far beyond basic literacy. It aspires to prepare these children for different levels of open schooling, providing a pathway to higher education. More than just academic excellence, the foundation is committed to equipping them with indispensable life skills, and nurturing qualities that go beyond the classroom and into the fabric of their daily lives.

Our Journey So Far



Utsav Foundation began its transformative journey on 19th June 2016 in a modest one-room space in the village of South City 1, Silokhra, Gurugram. With a clear mission to provide free education and skilling to underprivileged children, the foundation set out to empower society's most vulnerable members with the tools to lead lives of dignity, independence, and purpose.

From an initial batch of just 10 students, the foundation now proudly serves over 400 children as of December 2024. It continues to offer free access to quality education, along with books, notebooks, uniforms, stationery, digital devices, and—most importantly—a nurturing environment to dream big and grow holistically.

Over the years, Utsav has evolved from a one-room facility to a fully operational six-room education centre, equipped with LCDs, computers, blackboards, music systems, and CCTV-enabled classrooms. The centre also inaugurated a fully functional Science Lab in 2024, encouraging practical, STEM-based learning and curiosity-driven innovation among students.

A key advancement has been the establishment of a dedicated Computer Lab, where students receive hands-on training in computer graphics, programming, and web development. This initiative empowers students with relevant digital skills to thrive in today's tech-driven world. In parallel, Utsav also introduced yoga classes led by certified instructors, focusing on the physical and mental well-being of students, helping them build discipline, focus, and inner strength.

In response to ongoing educational gaps, Utsav continued its mobilization drives in 2024, reaching children living in underprivileged areas. Counselors worked closely with parents to bring their children into mainstream education. Many of these children initially struggled

with literacy and numeracy, some over the age of 10 had never attended formal school. With a play-based teaching model and highly committed educators, the foundation helped these children progress from basic alphabets and numbers to functional literacy, communication, and academic confidence.

Utsav also embraced technological advancement in education by distributing tablets (courtesy of Canara HSBC) to students from underprivileged backgrounds, enabling them to access digital learning resources. This initiative aimed to bridge the digital divide, promote interactive learning, and ensure continuity in education, especially in remote areas where access to traditional educational tools is limited. By empowering students with technology, Utsav reaffirmed its commitment to inclusive and future-ready education.

Launching the VISION platform, which supports student-led innovations through scholarships and mentorship, marked a significant step towards nurturing creativity and entrepreneurship among young minds. The platform provides a structured environment where students can develop their ideas, receive guidance from industry experts, and access financial support to bring their innovations to life. By fostering a culture of problem-solving and critical thinking, VISION empowers students to become changemakers and contribute meaningfully to their communities and beyond.

The Science Lab was officially inaugurated by Dr. Jitender Singh (Minister of State for Science and Technology), marking a milestone in Utsav's commitment to hands-on, experiential learning. The lab, made possible through generous funding from Roop Polymer, is equipped with modern scientific apparatus and resources aimed at fostering curiosity and a spirit of inquiry among students. This facility provides learners with the opportunity to conduct experiments, explore scientific concepts in depth, and cultivate a deeper understanding of the world around them, preparing them for future academic and professional pursuits in the field of science.

Utsav Foundation has played a pivotal role in mainstreaming education for underprivileged learners through the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) and Open Basic Education (OBE) programs. Between 2021 and 2024, a total of 192 students enrolled across levels 3rd, 5th, 8th, 10th, and 12th. Out of these, 74 students successfully passed, while 27 dropped out, and 91 students have their results currently awaited (mostly from the 2024–25 session).





The foundation has shown consistent improvement in both enrollment and passout numbers each year, reflecting its commitment to inclusive and alternative education pathways. These efforts provide second chances to children and youth who previously lacked access to formal schooling and aim to build a strong academic foundation for their futures.

The foundation further deepened its community roots by conducting diverse initiatives that blended education, health, culture, entrepreneurship, and social inclusion. From medical camps with Artemis Hospital to digital literacy drives, and cultural celebrations like Janmashtami, Holi, and Basant Panchami, every initiative was aimed at enriching the lives of students and their families. Students also showcased their talents through Diya and Mehndi stalls, gaining entrepreneurial exposure and life skills.

Support from well-wishers and corporate collaborators—such as Concentrix, Zomato's Feeding India, Elofic, and Roop Automotive—played a vital role in expanding the foundation's reach. In 2024, daily meals provided by Feeding India helped improve students' nutrition and attendance, while exposure visits and donation drives from corporate partners fueled confidence and capacity among learners. One of the proudest moments of the year was Utsav's victory in the Kashmir Premier League (KPL)—a testament to the foundation's commitment not just to academics, but to overall youth development through sports and teamwork.

As Utsav Foundation steps further into its ninth year, it stands as a growing symbol of transformation—where education is not a privilege, but a right, and where dreams find both roots and wings.



Empowering Education Through the Science Lab

One of the most significant milestones of the year was the inauguration of Utsav's fully equipped Science Lab, officially opened in 2024 by the esteemed Dr. Jitender Singh (Minister of State for Science and Technology). This remarkable development was made possible through the generous funding support of Roop Auto, whose contribution enabled the creation of a modern, hands-on learning environment for students.

The Science Lab is thoughtfully divided into three dedicated sections—Physics, Chemistry, and Biology—each tailored to suit the learning needs of students. The Physics Lab introduces concepts like light and magnetism through simple activities such as making periscopes and testing magnetic fields with iron fillings. In the Chemistry Lab, children safely experiment with mixing acids and bases using natural indicators like turmeric or litmus paper, helping them learn about chemical reactions in a fun, practical way. The Biology Lab features models and microscopes that let students examine plant cells, learn about the human body, and understand ecosystems using charts and real-life specimens like leaves and insects.

Since its launch, the lab has significantly enriched classroom learning, enabling both students and teachers to adopt a more experiential approach to science education. It has inspired a culture of inquiry and innovation, empowering young minds to question, explore, and discover. These hands-on experiments not only improve scientific understanding but also boost curiosity and confidence, laying a strong foundation for further learning. 
Launch of the VISION Platform




Pritam Singh Memorial Foundation Extends Scholarship Support to Utsav Foundation

This initiative marks another step in Utsav Foundation's mission to make quality healthcare accessible for all, reducing the burden of kidney-related ailments in the community.




Home Visits: Understanding Every Child's Reality


